- 10. Other duties as assigned

## **Application Instructions:**

- 1. All applications must be typed.
- 2. Fill out the application completely. Make a photocopy for yourself for your records.
- 3. All applications must be postmarked by **November 12, 2014.** Late applications will *not* be accepted.
- 4. Give the reference forms to two adults who know of your qualifications for a travel opportunity, and one teen girl. Those people may **not** be your relatives. References must return their forms **directly to the council** postmarked no later than **November 12, 2014** to be included in your completed application.
- 5. If you need more space on your application, you may continue your answers on up to two additional sheets only.

Balance your time between fun activites, a service project for the local community, and Girl Scout traditions and celebrations in the tropical paradise of Our Cabana's 5 acres of lush gardens. The group will spend 8 nights at the World Center exploring the culture and history of Mexico while participating in one of Our Cabana's summer programs.

## Additional Information:
