## **Open items**

- Recognitions Chair –Troop for November Mtg

*Oct Meeting – Pam’s ceremony went well. Suggestion was made to introduce a new song to Leaders at meetings. Pam can pick a song and print it out for leaders, but wants someone else to ‘lead’ the singing.*

- Pinewood Derby - how did it go? Review #s - *Snack’s brought in about \$100. A bit less than last year. Likely due to smaller attendance, and snack placement. S.H.A.R.E. patch sales went well! Summer will be submitting payments next week. Food pantry donations were good – 3 bags full. Committee discussed the new venue –there are pros and cons... but will look at getting back to St. Peter’s next year. Suggestion was made to keep races grouped by age levels.*
