- I. Call Meeting to Order Meeting called to order by Monica Lang

Cookie Sale Planning —Cookie Delivery Day — Lis - Volunteer status — Some troops still need to sign up for Cookie pickup time. Initial Cookie order for Service Unit is up 24% than previous years. Have not had an increase in several years. Seem to have quite a few volunteers for Cookie Delivery Day. Older girls may join but should let Lis know ahead of time. Need hand trucks and dollies. Pam will bring hers and Monica might have hand truck too. Sheila will get the keys from the school to open up that day. 8:30AM truck delivers. Try to get there a little before.

- f) Cookie Kickoff Report Lis/Katie Outcomes/Feedback haven't completed financial review/waiting on some receipts. ~79 girl scouts attended. We had 1 Council staff member join us (Robin). We had 6 girls show at the door. Some girls register didn't make it. Evened out with supplies. Hand enough to go around. Obtained girl surveys. Lots of good comments about the games. Loved the "candy land" game board and dice games. Note: Junior troop did say they got a bit "bored". Team discussed engaging the older girls differently but always a delicate balance. More Daisy/Brownies than 2nd year Juniors/Cadettes. Perhaps could have Juniors/Cadette put on skit comparing "good" selling vs. "bad" selling behaviors or display good cookie booth vs. bad cookie booth setup. Also, could have a separate event for only older girls SU Cookie party and sleepover/lockin. **ACTION Item:** Lis to provide financial report next team meeting.
- g) Treasurer's Report Treasure Roundtable Updates any payments/reimbursement/money earning projects Volunteer Tool Kit Finance Tab Update Finance Tab training Jan 18th "mandatory" Tanisha was not aware of training but would look for email/invite.
